



ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF

DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, with the impacts of PTC Eight on the coast of southeast North Carolina including the City of Boiling Spring Lakes; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described disaster, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

WHEREAS, declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered herein is necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to secure property.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as a Commissioner of Boiling Spring Lakes under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 7-76 of the Boiling Spring Lakes Code of Ordinances:

Section 1. A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of the City of Boiling Spring Lakes.

Section 2. The emergency area covered by this state of emergency shall be the entire corporate limits of the City.

Section 3. The following restrictions and prohibitions are imposed:

- A. **Evacuations:** Voluntary evacuation is being called for those who live in low-lying and flood-prone areas.
- B. **Curfew:** A city-wide curfew has been lifted, but we reserve the right to revisit a curfew.
- C. **Restricted Access:** None anticipated at this time but reserve the right to call for restricted access, limited entry or road closures.
- D. **Business Operations:** None anticipated at this time but reserve the right to call for restricted business operations.
- E. **Alcohol:** None anticipated at this time but reserve the right to call for restricted

alcohol consumption.


F. **Dangerous Weapons & Gasoline:** None anticipated at this time but reserve the right to call for restricted sale, purchase, storage.

Section 4. I hereby order all city law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws, and the Boiling Spring Lakes Emergency Response Plan.

Section 5. I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the public; (b) to be filed with Clerk to the City of Boiling Spring Lakes and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

Section 6. This declaration shall be extended and remain in effect until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 25, 2024.
